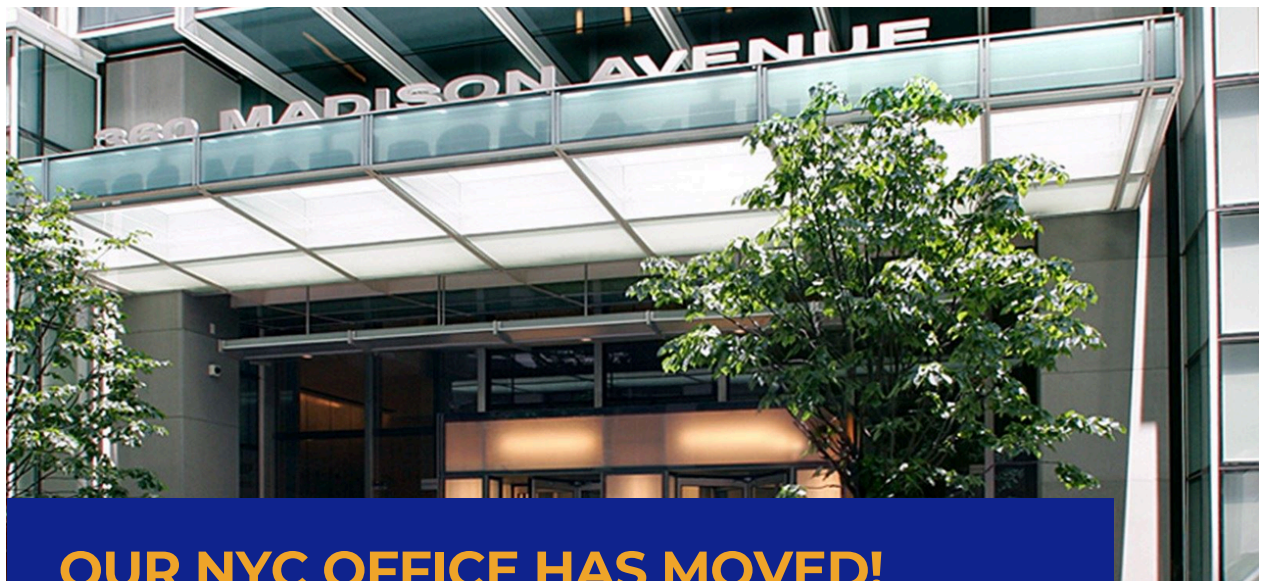


CAMPUS RECRUITING
